PRAYER AND PRAISE




Praise the Lord! God is aware of what is on your heart.

- ⇒ Traveling mercies and protection for Bonnie's sister Judy as she flies to Haiti to deliver medicines and help at a school there. Prayers for all who are suffering in Haiti.
- ⇒ Prayers of comfort for Katie's friend whose dad died from a brain tumor; praise for a beautiful memorial service. Prayers also for a coworker's 4-year-old daughter suffering from skull fractures after an accident at school. Prayers for Katie struggling with school.
- ⇒ Prayers for a member and spouse going through a rough patch in their marriage.
- ⇒ Lift up Tracey's client K.P., whose mother is critically ill with pneumonia in the ICU, in a medically-induced coma. Lift her mother up for healing.
- ⇒ Prayers for relief from pain for Tracey's mom, whose knees are bothering her again.

Lift up Kimberly's and videographer friend Steven's planned November 1st trip to assist "Hope for Eternity," which is now uncertain.
- ⇒ Prayers for Chris's friend whose worsening cancer prevented his return to Nigeria and left him in the ICU of a NY hospital. Prayers that his condition may stabilize sufficiently to permit his journey home.
- ⇒ A prayer of thanks for New Covenant Fellowship, as last Sunday Vernon's hug and kind, encouraging words to a regular visitor relieved her anxiety about an upcoming visit from her daughter suffering from drug addiction, giving her the courage she needed to respond to difficult situations with love.


